

PREP: Paper towels & a water cup for easy brush cleaning

STEP 1: Paint your background

(everything around the outside sketched image) **BLUE**

add some white to your blue, making a lighter blue -- you'll use this color + plain white to fill in your background -- just blend the white through as you work to even out the color

Towards the bottom of the canvas, you'll be using a bit darker blue -- to make the darker blue, add a little red into your mixed blue

STEP 2: Paint the rocket ship **WHITE** -- everything except the fins

STEP 3: Paint the fins **RED** and create a **RED** cone shape at the nose of your ship

STEP 4: Using **LIGHT GRAY** you're going to make a curved line at the bottom of your red cone, a curved line where the bottom of the fins meet the body of the ship, a curved line where the exhaust pipes meet the ship, and small curved lines at the bottom of each exhaust pipe

STEP 5: Using **LIGHT BLUE** paint exhaust from the pipes -- this color just needs to be lighter than what you have for the background

STEP 6: Using **VERY LIGHT BLUE** paint a small circle for the ship's window

STEP 7: Paint a **LIGHT GRAY** ring around your window

STEP 8: Paint planets and stars **WHITE** (2 coats)-- we will add color later!

STEP 9: When your planets and stars are dry, paint them any fun colors you like! I chose **YELLOW** for my stars, and did my planets **GREEN, ORANGE,** and **PURPLE**

STEP 10: Sign your masterpiece! Take pics and post to Facebook to show off your awesome creation!

COLOR MIXING:

LIGHT GRAY: Mix very little bits of **BLACK** in with some **WHITE** -- much less black than white

LIGHT BLUE: Mix **WHITE** & **BLUE** together -- roughly equal parts of both colors

VERY LIGHT BLUE: Add more **WHITE** to your **LIGHT BLUE**

GREEN: Mix **YELLOW** & **BLUE**

ORANGE: Mix **YELLOW** & **RED**

PURPLE: Mix **RED** & **BLUE**
