



LOVEBIRDS & PUMPKINS

STEP 1: Using very little white paint and a wet brush — lightly “wash” over the board -- before you begin, to ensure you have very little paint on your brush, dab it on a paper towel a bit -- you can always add more, but if you get too much on you’ll have a difficult time removing it

STEP 2: Paint you tree white, adding a few branches while its a little wet, add a little light gray to the right side of the trunk and a little bit to the undersides of the branches

STEP 3: Using very little black on your brush add some streaks to make your tree look like a birch tree -- start on the edge of the trunk and lightly brush inward -- add a tiny branch in the center towrds the top using black as well

STEP 4: Add leaves to your branches -- I did the red ones first and then layered lighter orange ones on top -- add a little yellow to your orange and add white -- you can add smaller branches to connect leaves if needed using a little black

STEP 5: Paint your birds black

STEP 6: Add white highlights to the birds when dry

STEP 7: Paint your pumpkins -- yellow one is painted yellow with a little white mixed in -- add a tiny bit of black to this color create the segments/shadows -- orange one is painted orange -- when dry add a little yellow and white into your orange for highlights -- add a little black to your orange for the segments/shadows -- the white pumpkin is painted white and for the shadows you’ll make dark brown using orange and black mixed together -- same color as the orange pumpkin segments

STEP 8: Paint stems on your pumpkins using dark brown — for highlights ass a little white to this color and streak on one side

STEP 9: Add a little white highlight to the yellow and orange pumpkin

STEP 10: Add a heart & initials to the trunk of the tree
